

#### Where are you from?







#### What is a difference between your and Czech/Slovak culture you think? 47 odpovedí




#### How do you think people behave to foreigners in Czech republic? 47 odpovedí




#### What do you think is the level of education in Czech republic?


What do you think is the most positive difference between your and Czech/Slovak culture? (what did you like the most from our culture)


What do you think is the most negative difference between your and Czech/Slovak culture?

- It is hard to find one (7x)




## 1. Do you think Czech people (in general) think differently than western europeans?




4. How many Czech people (you think) are hard working?




2. Do you think Czech people are (in general) open-minded?

5. What do you think - how many Czech people like their job/work/school?






### Can you imagine living in Czech/Slovak rep. longer than 4 years?
